DUCKY GAMES RULES

- You can steal the duck of an participant. P.S. Seniors can also steal your duck and they also have their own ducks that can be stolen.
- Don't use violence to get a duck or get back a duck. Once another player has the duck in their hand, it is secured.
- Do not go through someone's personal belongings. You can only steal someone's duck if they have it with them.
- You must always have the duck with you. Members of the IntroCee can request to steal your duck. If you fail to show it, you are disqualified. Members of the IntroCee cannot steal your duck while conducting checks.
- Once a duck has been stolen and placed in the graveyard, it cannot be stolen again. Please do not take ducks from the graveyard.
- Once a duck has been stolen, its eyes are marked with X-s, the original player name is striked, the name of the player that stole it is written on it and it is placed in the graveyard.
- Please follow common safety and social rules when playing. No harassment, sexual assault, violence or vulgar language is allowed.
- The player that has stolen the most ducks at the end of the weekend has won the Ducky Games and will get a prize.
